PROPOSAL/QUOTATION ADVERTISED IN NEWSPAPERS ON 24TH JANUARY 2018 BY THE PRINCIPAL/PROJECT DIRECTOR-CADET COLLEGE SANGHAR

Reference: Your Letter No.TL18/2501/4A dated 25th January 2018.

Apropos reference, it is intimated that the quotation/proposal was advertised basically to get the technical opinion about the strength of severely deteriorated RCC structure of old overhead water tank which was constructed 25 years ago that whether it will be feasible/economical to strengthen/repair the RCC structure or to demolish it.

The matter was discussed in the 26th meeting of the Board of Governors–Cadet College Sanghar and as per directives of the Board to consult some reputable firms for assessment of strength of the structure of old overhead water tank, the advertisement was floated in the leading newspapers in the light of Board directives. The quotation/ proposals will be presented in the forthcoming BoGs meeting for further necessary step and decision.

As per directives of the Board in its 26th meeting, the proposal for installation of Solar Panels for the Cadets Residential Area both for online/offline grid system, were invited. All the proposals received will be presented before the Board in its forthcoming meeting for perusal.

Above in view, as the quotations/proposals advertised are of advisory/ recommending in nature based on technical opinions and will be decided in the forthcoming meeting of the Board keeping in view the feasibility/availability of the requisite funds, therefore the date and time for opening of quotations/proposals was not mentioned.

However, it is pertinent to note that Cadet College Sanghar strictly follows the SPPRA rules 2010 for the procurement of works/materials and services in true letter and spirit.
