**SUBJECT: HOISTING OF NIT'S, BER'S AND OTHER RELATED DOCUMENTS ON SPPRA WEBSITE AND ALLOCATION OF SPPRA ID'S IN TIME.**

Dear Sir,

You are well aware that Shaheed Mohtarma Benazir Bhutto Medical University (SMBBMU) Larkana, is the public sector Medical University in the Sindh Province. Since, there are vast procurement activities to be carried out from time to time for goods, works & services in the University. Also, this University is strictly following the SPPRA Rules to maintain transparency and avoid mis-procurements.


It has been observed that documents viz NIT's of various tenders and their related documents i.e. Bid Evaluation Reports etc are not being hoisted on SPPRA website in due course of time and took almost 10 – 15 days in hoisting the documents, resulting which the University is facing disturbances in awarding the contracts. However, after opening of tenders, we always try our level best to send required documents to SPPRA authorities in time for hoisting on the website.

As such, the Rule-50 of SPPRA Rules states that within seven days of the award of contract, procuring agency shall publish on the website of the Authority and on its own website. Also, only serial Nos are allocated for the University tenders and SPPRA IDs are not being allocated despite of providing all the required documents by the University due to reasons best known to SPPRA authorities.

As you know, the Government of Sindh provide funds, which are lapsable therefore, if the same are not utilized in time then the same would be lapsed.

In view of the above facts, you are therefore, requested to expedite the issues of hoisting the documents on SPPRA website to avoid delay in award of contracts, so that the funds can be utilized in time and the University could be saved from embarrassments.
