Sub: Violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004, Commander of MES, Office of Military Engineering Services (PAF) Faisal, Karachi's Tender Notice for Provision of Non- Residential Facilities.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to Military Engineering Services (PAF) Faisal, Karachi's Tender Notice published in daily "Dawn" on 30<sup>th</sup> October, 2015. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the PPRA Rules 2004.

1. As per advertisement, "it is mentioned that the tender forms will be issued on 20-11-15". It is violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004, Rule No. 23 (1). Stated as under;

*23. Bidding documents. - (1) Procuring agencies shall formulate precise and unambiguous bidding documents that shall be made available to the bidders immediately after the publication of the invitation to bid.*

2. Also, it is mentioned that "The accepting officer reserves the right to reject the tender without quoting any reason". It is a violation of PPRA Rules 2004, Rule No.33 (1). Stated as under;

*33. Rejection of bids. - (1) The procuring agency may reject all bids or proposals at any time prior to the acceptance of a bid or proposal. The procuring agency shall upon request communicate to any supplier or contractor who submitted a bid or proposal, the grounds for its rejection of all bids or proposals, but is not required to justify those grounds.*

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 50, and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

Transparency International Pakistan is striving for across the board application of Rule of Law, which is the only way to stop corruption.

(b) Tender documents shall be made available to the bidders after the publication of the invitation to bid.

**NOTE:** Contractors shall provide certificate that they are not involved in any type of litigation with Government Department in the Court of Law and that no special report of Directorate of Inspection and Evaluation (E-in-C's Branch GHQ Rwp.) is outstanding against them.

4. Contractor born on approved list of MES in Categories 'B' & 'C' and also having experience of this type of work may only apply.

5. Contractors who desire may be present at the time of opening of tenders.

6. The accepting officer reserves the right to accept or reject the tender without quoting any reason. Rejected tenders will be dealt with as per Para 33(1) of PPR Rules 2004.
