Sub: Violation of Sindh Public Procurement Rules 2010, Executive Engineer (Civil), Sports & Youth Affairs Department (Engineering Wing), Karachi's Tender Notice for Laying of Synthetic Football Turf.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to Sports & Youth Affairs Department (Engineering Wing), Karachi's Tender Notice, published in daily "Dawn" on 7th December, 2017. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the Sindh Public Procurement Rules 2010.

As per advertisement, the undersigned has restricted the bidders for works of 'Laying of Synthetic Football Turf' of European/ USA origin only and has not added "**or equivalent**" with it, which is violation of Sindh Public Procurement Rules 2010, Rule No. 13 (1). Stated as under;

13. Specifications: - (1) Specifications shall allow the widest possible competition and shall not favor any single contractor or supplier nor put others at a disadvantage. Specifications shall be generic and shall not include references to brand names, model numbers, catalogue numbers or similar classifications. However, if the procuring agency is convinced that the use of a reference to a brand name or a catalogue number is essential to complete an otherwise incomplete specification, such use or reference shall be qualified with the words "or equivalent."

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 32(A), and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

Transparency International Pakistan is striving for across the board application of Rule of Law, which is the only way to stop corruption.

1. Sealed tenders are invited from the firms registered with Pakistan Engineering Council in Category C-5 and SRB (Sindh Revenue Board) may apply which fulfill the following merits. The rates should be quoted in local currency. The tender forms of the subject works can be obtained on payment of Rs. 3000/- of each tender / work (non-refundable) in shape of Bank Draft / Pay Order in the name of Executive Engineer (Civil) Sports & Youth Affairs Department, Government of Sindh on any working day during office hours. The documents will be issued from the date of publication / hoisting this notice i.e. from 05-12-2017 to 22-12-2017.

Terms & Conditions:

- List of previous laying of synthetic turfs along with relevant record showing cost of projects of the last three years along with at least one full size Football Turf Project (European / USA brand).
- The Football Turfs should be certified by FIFA approved.
- All taxes, import duties, sales tax, income tax and other levies, if any, clearance charges including transportation from port to site should include in the bid amount.
- L.C. will be opened by contractor at his own arrangement.
- Supply, Laying of Synthetic Football Turf Work in all respect to be completed within time.
- The placement of firm supply order, complete specification along with samples of Synthetic Football Turf, its technical details, brochures and literature should accompany the bid.
- Ten years warranty would also be required after taking over the project.
- Agency Certificate from the suppliers with proof of previous business of the at least 03 years.
- Being specialized work having experience of sports related (civil work of relevant field) work for the last three years.

- Pakistan Engineering Council in Category C-5 and above.
- The bid amount should be included all the Government taxes, such as FBR and SRB or if any other will be borne by the contractors.
- Any increase / change in Government taxes at the time on or before awarding work will not be entertained by the Department.
- NTN Registration Certificate.
- Sindh Revenue Board (SRB) Registration Certificate.
- Award letters in relevant field.
- Current Contract Commitments / Works in progress.
- Financial Capabilities, Bank Statement etc. for the last three years (Rs. 60,000 million) of each work.
- Conditional / telegraphic applications will not be entertained for purchase of tenders.
- Affidavit regarding not debarred / blacklisted for further tendering.

2. Tenders will be received on 26th December, 2017 upto 1300 hours and will be opened on the same day at 1400 hours in presence of Committee and bidders or their representatives.

3. In case Chairman Procurement Committee or undersigned is not available in Headquarters the tenders will be opened on 28th December, 2017.

4. Bank Draft / Pay Order in the name of Executive Engineer, Sports & Youth Affairs Department, Karachi as earnest money equivalent to 2% of the amount of bid must be attached with the tender. Conditional/ incomplete tenders will not be accepted.

5. The Procuring Agency may reject any bid subject to relevant provision of SPP Rules 2010 and may cancel the bidding process at any time prior to acceptance of bid or proposal as per Rule-25(I) of the said rules.
