Sub: Violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004, Director, Civil Aviation Training Institute,
Hyderabad's Tender Notice for Provision of Trained Arms Guards.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to Civil Aviation Training Institute, Hyderabad's Tender Notice for Provision of Trained Arms Guards, published in daily "Dawn" on 5th February, 2016. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the Public Procurement Rules 2004.

As per advertisement, "PCAA reserves all right to accept or reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason and its decision will be final and shall not be challenged", which is violation of PPRA Rules 2004, Rule No. 33. Stated as under:

33. Rejection of bids:- (1) The procuring agency may reject all bids or proposals at any time prior to the acceptance of a bid or proposal. The procuring agency shall upon request communicate to any supplier or contractor who submitted a bid or proposal, the grounds for its rejection of all bids or proposals, but is not required to justify those grounds.

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 50, and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

Transparency International Pakistan is striving for across the board application of Rule of Law, which is the only way to stop corruption.

TECHNICAL OFFERS.

- I) Profile and history of Company/firms.
 - II) Registration of firm Memorandum and Article of Association
 - III) The undertaking/Affidavits attested by notary Public on Non-Judicial stamp paper of appropriate value shall be submitted for not having any litigation against CAA.
 - IV) Details of employment, experience of armed guards should be provided.
 - V) Refresher training, last schedule, and frequency.
 - VI) Last 03 years evidence of income tax returns file.
 - VII) Valid License of Ministry of Interior and Provincial Govt. to run security agency.
 - VIII) Registration with Income Tax Authorities, Sindh Government for Sales Tax, EOBI and ESSI.
 - IX) Description of fire arms/weapons with documentary proof of arm license.
 - X) Separate quotation be given for armed guards belonging to Ex-Army.
 - XI) Last 03 years bank statement and certificates.
 - XII) Audited financial statement for the last three years.
 - XIII) Bids validity shall be considered effective for five (05) months from the date of opening of tender.
4. Single sealed envelope should be dropped in the tender box placed at the reception of Director CATI Hyderabad on 23rd February, 2016. The box will be sealed at 1200 Hrs. and no bid shall be received thereafter. Tenders shall be opened by the Tender Opening committee at 1230 Hrs. on the same day in the presence of bidders/their representatives who may like to be present.
