Sub: Violation of Sindh Public Procurement Rules 2010, Director General, Transport and Mass Transmit Department, Karachi's Invitation of Proposal Notice for Inter-City Peoples' Bus Scheme for Sindh.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to Transport and Mass Transmit Department, Karachi's Invitation of Proposal Notice published in daily "Dawn" on 7th October, 2017. It is observed that the advertisements are in violation of the SPPRA Rules 2010.

No response time is mentioned in the advertisement for applicants for the submission of proposals. It is violation of Sindh Procurement Rules 2010, Rule No. 18(1). The Rule is stated as under;

18. Response Time (1), the response time shall not be less than fifteen calendar days from the date of publication of Notice Inviting Tender in the newspapers or hoisting in the website, as the case may be, in case of National Competitive Bidding, and shall not be less than forty five days from the date of publication of Notice Inviting Tender in the newspapers or hoisting on the website, as provided in Rule 17 (6), in case of International Competitive Bidding;

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding the mis-procurement charge under Rule No 32(A), and with request to re-invite the notice under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

Transparency International Pakistan is striving for across the board application of Rule of Law, which is the only way to stop corruption.
