Reminder on TI-Pakistan’s letter No. TL17/2402/7A dated 24th February, 2017

Dear Sir,

TI-Pakistan has not received any reply of its letter No. TL17/2402/7A dated 24th February, 2017 on the above mentioned procurement, on which HEC had requested input from TI- Pakistan.

The following information was requested;

Kindly provide Haier establishment plant location under the contract awarded in 2014 and 2015. What is the total production of laptops in 2015 and 2016 and what advantage it is to Pakistan? On Haier’s website there is no information about its laptops manufacturing in Pakistan, and not a single laptop made by Haier in Pakistan is on sale.

TI-Pakistan has received credible information that the supplier of previous contracts for 200, 000 laptops, did not import laptops in ckd condition, and has infact manipulated the supply, and did not assemble a single piece of laptops in Pakistan.

Further document about the manipulated supply of the previous supplier will be sent to you later.

You are requested to kindly postpone this tender, and hold detailed inquiry on the supply of 200, 000 laptops prior to taking any initiative on this tender.

Transparency International Pakistan is striving for across the board application of Rule of Law, which is the only way to stop corruption.
