Sub: Violation of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rules 2014, Executive Engineer, Provincial Building Construction Division-II, C & W Department, Peshawar's Tender Notice for Establishment of Casualty Block.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to Provincial Building Construction Division-II, Peshawar's Tender Notice, published in daily "Aaj" on 9th January, 2017. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the KPK Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rules 2014.


As per advertisement, 15 days of response time is not given and the last date for the submission of bids is given as 18-01-2017, which is 5 days short and is violation of KPPRA Rules 2014, Rule No.34 (1). Stated as under:

13. Response time. - (1) The procuring agency may decide the response time for receipt of bids or proposals (including proposals for pre-qualification) from the date of publication of an advertisement or notice, keeping in view the individual procurement's complexity, availability and urgency. However, under no circumstances the response time shall be less than fifteen days for national competitive bidding and thirty days for international competitive bidding from the date of publication of advertisement or notice.

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 54, with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

TERMS & CONDITIONS.

- Technical Bid / proposal should accompany the following:
 - Certified that bid security in the shape of Call Deposit (original) has been enclosed in financial bid.
 - Enlistment order of C&W Department (photo copy).
 - Renewal of Registration for CFY 2016-17 (photo copy)
 - Computerized National Identity Card (photo copy)
 - Pakistan Engineering Council Registration copy for calendar year 2016.
 - Form-H of the company / firm
 - Documents showing general capabilities, financial soundness, general and relevant experience record, personnel capabilities, equipment detail and availability and Income Tax / NTN certificates h. Any other documents to support the technical bid.
- Technical Evaluation will be carried out with pass / fail threshold in passing all the fields including PEC Registration, enlistment with C&W Deptt. Tax Payer proof, relevant experience in past 05-years, performance, Technical personnel, required equipment, financial status, auditor's report, managerial capabilities, litigation status etc.
- The bidders are required to send their Technical & Financial bids through courier in duplicate in separate envelop clearly marked as Original & Duplicate. The original shall be sent to the Executive Engineer Provincial Building (Construction) Division-II, Peshawar and the duplicate to the Superintending Engineer Provincial Building (Construction), Peshawar. Both the original and duplicate bids must reach the concerned office on or before the closing date and time.
- Financial bid should include priced BOQ (hand written in figures and words) and bid security.
- Incomplete conditional / electronics bids and bids received after closing date shall not be entertained. Bids shall be signed by authorized persons.
- The contractors / bidders who quote their bids / rates more than 10% below the engineering estimate shall submit an additional security in the form of call deposit equal to 8% of the bid cost. After commencement of works by the successful bidders 8% call deposit may be replaced with a bank guarantee of the same amount from the scheduled bank.
- The additional security shall be released to the contractor in four installments i.e. 25% to be released after completion 25% of the project, 50% to be released upon 50% completion, 75% to be released upon 75% completion and the remaining amount to be released after completion of the project. In case the bidder quotes more than 10% below the bid cost and the bid is not accompanied by the additional security then the bid shall be considered as non-responsive and the 2nd lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.
- The tenders shall be processed according to "above / below system" based on the Market Rate System.
- If the performance bond or bank guarantee (which ever the case may be) is not provided by the bidder in the required period then offer will be given to the next lowest bidder and so on and the bid security of the defaulter bidder will be forfeited.
- Any bidder who provides incorrect information should be disqualified.
- Time allowed for completion of the work is as specified in the NIT which will start from the issuance of work order.
- Bid will be valid for 90 days.
- Successful bidder should sign the agreement with the Department within 7-days after acceptance of bid.
- Call Deposit of scheduled bank will be acceptable.
- If the evaluated bid costs of two or more than two bidders are same then the successful bid will be declared through draw.
- Technical bid will be opened after 30-minutes of closing time in the present of bidders / their representatives who choose to be present.
- Financial bid will be opened on later date will communicated to technically qualified bidders only.
- If duplicate copy of bid differ from its original then the bid will be declared as non-responsive.
- The employer has the authority to reject any bid or all the bids assigning valid reason.
- Bid security of the first, 2nd and 3rd bidders for the specific work will be retained by the department upto approval of tender.
- Only authorized Dealers/Manufactures and contractors can submit their applications who were already executed the same nature of work.
