Sub: Violation of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rules 2014, Hospital Director, Medical Teaching Institution, DHQ Teaching Hospital, D.I.Khan's Tender Notice for Purchase of Miscellaneous Items.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to MTI, DHQ Teaching Hospital, D.I.Khan's Tender Notice, published in daily "Express" on 9<sup>th</sup> December, 2016. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the KPK Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rules 2014.

As per advertisement, "The Number of items and budget can be increased/decreased", whereas any change in tender conditions, specifications and quantity after bid opening by procuring agency is not allowed under Rules. However, according to KPPRA Rules 2014, Rule No.10, repeat orders cannot exceed more than 15% of the original quantity. Stated as under:

*10. Alternate methods for procurement of goods.--- A procurement entity may use the following alternative methods for procurement of goods, namely:*

*(c) a procurement entity shall only engage in alternate method if the following conditions exist, namely:*


*(i) repeat orders within a period of six months:*

*Provided that it does not exceed fifteen percent of the original contract value;*

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 54, with request to re-invite the EOI under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.
