Sub: Violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004, Bursar, The Pakistan Steel Cadet College,
Karachi's Tender Notice for Licensing out of Cafeteria.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to Pakistan Steel Cadet College, Karachi's Tender Notice, published in daily "The News" on 13th August, 2016. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the PPRA Rules 2004.

As per advertisement, no response time is given for bidders for the submission/ opening of bids. It is a violation of PPRA Rules 2004, Rule No.13 (1). Stated as under;

13. Response time. - (1) The procuring agency may decide the response time for receipt of bids or proposals (including proposals for pre-qualification) from the date of publication of an advertisement or notice, keeping in view the individual procurement's complexity, availability and urgency. However, under no circumstances the response time shall be less than fifteen days for national competitive bidding and thirty days for international competitive bidding from the date of publication of advertisement or notice.

It is mentioned in PPRA 'Tender Guidelines' on their website, that Tender Notice should contain closing date, time and place for receiving bids, as well as time of public opening of bids (Copy Attached).

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 50, and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.
