Sub: Violation of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rules 2014, Chairman Procurement Committee, Project of Computerization of Land Records, Board of Revenue, Peshawar's Tender Notice for Procurement of Items for IT Department.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to Board of Revenue, Peshawar's Tender Notice published in daily "Express" on 16th April, 2018, 2018. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the KPPPRA Rules 2014.

As per advertisement, "Quantity of items can be increased/decrease by the Competent Authority", whereas any change in tender conditions, specifications and quantity after bid opening by procuring agency is not allowed under Rules. However, according to KPPPRA Rules 2014, No.10, repeat orders cannot exceed more than 15% of the original quantity. Stated as under;

*10. Alternate methods for procurement of goods.--- A procurement entity may use the following alternative methods for procurement of goods, namely:
(c) a procurement entity shall only engage in alternate method if the following conditions exist, namely:
(i) repeat orders within a period of six months:
Provided that it does not exceed fifteen percent of the original contract value;*

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 54, with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

Bids will be evaluated under **Single Stage, two Envelope Procedure (Rule 6 (2) (b))** of KPPRA rules 2014.

The Bidder / firm should have at-least 5 years of relevant experience in Supply of IT equipment.

The Bidder / Firm must have a registered office / Authorized dealer in Peshawar.

The Competent Authority reserves the right to reject or accept all the proposals at any time prior to acceptance of a bid or proposal.

The Government taxes will be recovered from the Bidder / Supplier from their invoices / Bills at source at the time of Payments whose bids / proposals are accepted.

The Bidder / firm shall apply for each item separately, in a separate envelop clearly showing name of Items applied for.

The bidder should provide an undertaking on stamp paper that it is not blacklisted or bank defaulter and also not involved in any litigation with any department for past three years by any of the Organization of the state / Federal / Provincial Government in Pakistan.

The bidder should provide the Manufacturer's Authorization Letter in IT equipment.

Quantity of items can be increased / decreased by the Competent Authority.

Warranty period shall not be less than three years.

The 2% Security bid / earnest money will be retained till the expiry of Warranty.

The successful bidder/firm shall be responsible for free of cost repair or replacement of all Equipment during warranty period.
