**Sub: Violation of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services
Rules 2014, Executive Engineer, C&W Division, Lakki Marwat's Tender Notice for
Miscellaneous Works.**

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to C&W Division, Lakki Marwat's Tender Notice published in daily "Nawaiwaqt" on 18th July, 2017. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the KPPRA Rules 2014.

As per the advertisement, 15 days of response time is not given and the last date for submission of bids is given on 27-04-2017, which is 5 days short. It is a violation of KPPRA Rules 2014, Rule No.34 (1). Stated as under:

***34. Response time.---**(1) The procuring entity may decide the response time for receipt of bids or proposals including proposals for pre-qualification from the date of publication of an advertisement or notice, keeping in view the contract's complexity, and urgency. However, under no circumstances the response time shall be less than fifteen days for national competitive bidding and thirty days for international competitive bidding from the date of publication of advertisement or notice in the national newspaper.*

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 54, with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

The Bidders should be registered with Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) in relevant category & field of specialisation with C&W Department and should have adequate financial soundness, relevant experience, personnel capabilities, required equipment and others as included in ITB.

1. Bid documents including Tender Form, BOQ and instruction to bidders can be downloaded up to one day prior to the opening date from C&W web site (www.CWD.gkp.pk).
2. Original Bid Security in the shape of call deposit in the name of Executive Engineer C&W Division Lakki Marwat shall accompany the financial bid.
3. The bidders are required to send their bid (Technical & Financial) through courier in duplicate in separate envelopes clearly marked as Original and Duplicate. The original shall be sent to the Executive Engineer, C&W Division Lakki Marwat and the duplicate to Superintending Engineer, C&W Circle Baran. Both the Original and Duplicate bids shall reach the concerned office before closing date and time.

**GOVT. OF KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA C&W DEPARTMENT INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS
(KPPRA single stage two envelope bidding procedure)**

1. Technical bid/proposal should accompany the following:
 - a. Certificate that Bid Security in the shape of deposit or call (original) has been enclosed in financial bid.
 - b. Enlistment Order of C&W Department (Photocopy).
 - c. Renewal of registration for CFY 2017-18 (Photocopy).
 - d. National Identity Card (NIC) (Photocopy).
 - e. Pakistan Engineering Council Registration copy for calendar year 2017.
 - f. Form H of the Company/Firm.
 - g. Documents showing general capabilities, financial soundness, general and relevant experience record, personnel capabilities, equipment capabilities and income Tax/NTN Certificates.
 - h. Any other document to support the technical bid.
2. Technical evaluation will be carried out with pass/fail threshold in passing all the fields including PEC Registration, Enlistment with C&W Department, Tax Payer proof, Relevant experience in past 05 years, performance, Technical Personnel, required Equipment, Financial status, Auditors report, Managerial capabilities, Litigation status etc.
3. Technical and financial bids should be in sealed envelopes clearly marked "Technical Bid" and "Financial Bid". Complete bids (both original and duplicate) must reach the concerned offices on or before the feed date/time.
4. Financial bid should include Priced BOQ (hand written in figures and words) and Bid Security.
5. Incomplete/conditional/Electronic bids and bids received after closing time shall not be entertained. Bids shall be signed by authorized persons.
6. The Contractor/Bidders, who quote their bid/costs more than 10% below the Engineer Estimate, shall submit an additional Security in the form of call deposit equal to 5% of the bid cost.
7. In case the bidder quotes more than 10% below the bid cost and the bid is not accompanied by the additional security then the bid shall be considered as non-responsive and the 2nd bidder and so on will be consider accordingly.
8. All the tenders shall be processed according to "Above/Below System" based on the Market Rate System.
9. Any bidder who provides incorrect information should be disqualified.
10. Time allowed for completion of the work is as specified in the NIT which will start from the issuance of work order.
11. Bids will be valid for Ninety (90) days.
12. Successful bidder should sign the agreement with department within Seven (07) days after acceptance of bid.
13. Call Deposit of Scheduled Banks shall be acceptable.
14. If the evaluated bid costs of two or more than two bidders are same then the successful bid will be declared through draw.
15. Technical bids will be opened after 30 minutes of closing time in the presence of bidders/their representatives who choose to be present.
16. Financial bids will be opened on later date will communicated to technically qualified bidders only.
17. If duplicate copy of any bid differs from its original, then the bid will be declared a non-responsive.
18. The employer has the authority to reject any bid or all the bids assigning cogent reasons.
19. Bid security of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd bidder for the specific work will be retained by the Department up to approval of Tender.
20. All other terms/Conditions/Documents can be seen in the office of the undersigned on any working day during office hours.
