Sub: Violation of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rules 2014, Managing Director, SIBD, Peshawar's Pre-Qualification Notices for Establishment of Small Industrial Estate & Rehabilitation of Infrastructure Facilities.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to SIBD, Peshawar's Pre-Qualification Notice published in daily "Dawn" on 17th October, 2015. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the KPPRA Rules 2014.

As per advertisement, "no pre-qualification document is issued for bidders". However, according to KPPRA 2014, Page 18, the 'Pre-qualification process' clause, a set of prequalification document that includes evaluation criteria should be provided to the applicants. The Rule is quoted below for your reference;

Pre-qualification process.--(1) The procuring entity engaging in pre-qualification shall announce, in the pre-qualification documents, all information required for pre-qualification including instructions for preparation and submission of the pre-qualification documents, evaluation criteria, list of documentary evidence required of contractors or consultants to demonstrate their respective qualifications and any other information that the procuring entity deems necessary for pre-qualification.


(2) The procuring entity shall provide a set of pre-qualification documents to any contractor or consultant, on request and subject to payment of document fee if applicable, which shall not exceed cost of printing and providing the documents.

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement, mentioned KPPRA 2014, page 22 stated as under; and with request to re-invite the pre-qualification under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

Mis-procurement.-- Any breach of these rules shall amount to mis-procurement and the person responsible for such breach shall be liable to be proceeded under the relevant law.

The interested Firms/Contractors should submit their Technical Bids separately for the above schemes/works latest by the 2nd November, 2015 till 11.00 A.M. Technical Bids will be opened by committee in Directorate of Implementation SIDB in presence of the concerned contractors/their representatives on the same day at 11.30-A.M. No application/documents will be acceptable after the due date and repetition of documents will not be considered.

The Technical Bids should contain the following information.

1. Complete Bio-data of the contractors/firms/location of Head Office/list of staff with complete detail and proof, which will be available during execution of the project.
2. List of projects in hands (with work orders) and those completed during the last five years with cost & completion certificate.
3. Details of Tools, Plants & Machinery available with the contractor for execution of works.
4. Renewed Registration with C&W Department as well as Pakistan Engineering Council in the relevant category for the current year.
5. List of staff employed and pay sheets for last six months.
6. Bank statement of the contractor from a scheduled Bank for the last 6-months showing financial status of the party.
7. The Income Tax certificate, assessment certificate of the department showing tax payment regarding works/projects executed in the last five years.
8. Audit report from an external auditor for the last three years.
9. An affidavit on stamp paper to the effect that there is no dispute/litigation with any Government Department/organization.
10. The firms/contractors will be bound to ensure verification by the authorized officer of the department to check the store, machinery and steel shuttering etc. physically.
11. Telegraphically/Incomplete/Conditional application/documents will not be acceptable.
12. Any other documents which the interested parties may consider necessary to be considered in the pre-qualification.
13. If a contractor/firm supplies incorrect information/documents, it will be recommended to the higher authorities for dis-qualification, if found at any stage.
