Sub: Violation of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rules 2014, Dean, Bannu Medical College, Bannu's Tender Notice for Hiring of Security Services.

This is with reference to Bannu Medical College, Bannu's Tender Notice, published in daily "Aaj" on 25th July, 2019. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the KPPPRA Rules 2014.

As per advertisement, the bid submission will be within 15 days after advertisement, while the bid opening will be on the next day. Therefore, the advertisement is in violation of KPPPRA Rules 2014, Rule No.37 (6). Stated as under;

37. Submission of bids and bid opening: — (6) All announcements pertaining to public procurement shall specify the last date for submission of bids as well as the public bid opening which shall be the same.

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 54, with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1 As per KP Procurement Rules-2014. Rule 38(2) (a) single stage-two envelopes bidding procedure, Both Tenders (Technical + Financial) should be submitted in separate envelopes marked as Technical and Financial. In the first instance, the "Technical Proposal" shall be opened and "Financial Proposal will be opened only for technically compliant bidders.
- 2 Proposal must contain Bid Security in shape of CDR, Bank Draft, or pay Order equivalent to 2% of the estimated price (Estimated price Rs. 4,000,000) in favor of " Dean Bannu Medical College, Bannu" with out which the offer shall be rejected being non-responsive.
- 3 Initially, the contract will be for the period of one year but can be renewed for further two years with the mutual understanding and after approval of Competent authority BMC MTI Bannu, i.e. Dean Bannu Medical College, Bannu.
