Sub: Violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004, Chief Engineer (Development), PMU, TESCO, Peshawar's Request for Proposal Notice for Providing Engineering Consultancy Services.


This is with reference to PMU, TESCO, Peshawar's RFP Notice, published in daily "Jang" on 24th September, 2019. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the PPRA Rules 2004.

As per terms and condition No. 5 in the advertisement, "Tesco reserves the right to accept or reject any/all applications at any stage without assigning any reason thereof". It is not complying with PPRA Rules 2004, Rule No. 33, which requires that reason should be communicated to bidders. Stated as under:

33. Rejection of bids:- (1) The procuring agency may reject all bids or proposals at any time prior to the acceptance of a bid or proposal. The procuring agency shall upon request communicate to any supplier or contractor who submitted a bid or proposal, the grounds for its rejection of all bids or proposals, but is not required to justify those grounds.

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 50, and with request to re-invite the RFP under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

1. Tribal Areas Electric Supply Company (TESCO) invites proposals from consultants for providing Engineering Consultancy Services including Construction Supervision, approval of Technical Data / Drawings for construction of following projects under Deposit Works, Ten Years Development Plan & Annual Development Program of merged Tribal Districts of KPK.

- Conversion of 66kV Grid Station Kalaya to 132kV level, Associated 132kV SDT transmission line 15km (with ACSR Lynx conductor) from 132kV Kohat KDA Grid Station along with 132kV line bay at Kohat KDA Grid Station. 04 Bedrooms rest house and mosque for Grid Station colony.
- Conversion of 66kV Grid Station Ghiljo to 132kV level, Associated 132kV SDT transmission line 55km (with ACSR lynx conductor) from 132kV Hangu Grid Station along with 132kV line bay at Hangu Grid Station.
- Conversion of 66kV Grid Station Warsak Pump House into 132kV level, Associated 132kV SDT transmission line 12km (with ACSR Lynx conductor) from 132kV Jamrud Grid Station along with 132kV line bay at Jamrud Grid Station.
- Construction of New 132kV Grid Station at Nothem Mohmand (Khwezai/Bezai), Associated 132kV SDT transmission line 30 km (with ACSR Lynx conductor) from 132kV Ghallanai Grid Station alongwith line bay at 132kV Ghallanai Grid Station. 04 Bedrooms rest house and mosque for Grid Station colony.
- Conversion of 66kV Grid Station Alizai to 132kV level, Associated 132kV SDT transmission line 32km (with ACSR Rail conductor) from 132kV Tall Grid Station along with 132kV line bay at Tall Grid Station (two line bays at 132kV Alizai Grid Station for provision of In/Out arrangement).
- Conversion of 66kV Grid Station Sadda to 132kV level, Associated 132kV SDT transmission line 25km (with ACSR Rail conductor) from 132kV Alizai Grid Station along with line bay at 132kV Alizai Grid Station (two line bays at 132kV Sadda Grid Station for provision of In/Out arrangement).

2. Following are the major components of the said project:

- Approval / Vetting of Drawing / Design, Technical Data, Survey Route, Plan Tabling and Profile of Transmission Line.
- Technical & Financial review and vetting of estimates prepared by the client.
- Vetting of Implementation schedule for Engineering / Construction activities
- Construction supervision.
- Monitoring overall construction and delivery schedule and close coordination / liaison between concerned organizations / parties.
- Verification of contractor's bills and claims.
- Measurement of final quantities and preparation of final statement of payments due to the contractor(s).
- To prepare and submit monthly progress reports on physical and financial progress of the project.
- Witnessing of Testing, commissioning and handing over the project to the client, preparation of final completion report / as built drawings and issuance of final completion / acceptance certificate. Supervision during defect liability period.
- Any services which are not specifically mentioned but are allied and essential will be considered as a part of services.

3. TESCO now invites sealed cover bids from consultants for providing the services. The Consultant / joint ventures registered with Pakistan Engineering Council having minimum five (05) years of similar consultancy experience in 132kV or higher voltage level projects with sound financial background and should have supervised construction of at least 02 projects of 132kV Grid Station and 132kV Transmission Line or higher voltage level each with a length of at least 60km as a main consultant may apply with complete and comprehensive detail.

4. The technical and financial proposal along-with all information as per RFP documents are to be submitted (one original) in sealed cover by 1200 Hrs dated 11.10.2019. The technical proposal shall be opened by the committee on the same day at 1230 Hrs in the presence of bidders / the representative who wish to be present. The date of opening of financial proposals shall be communicated to the technically successful bidders accordingly.

5. Bids received after the prescribed time and date shall be rejected. TESCO reserves the rights to accept or reject any / all applications at any stage without assigning any reason thereof.

6. RFP documents can be obtained from the office of Chief Engineer (Dev) PMU TESCO HQ WAPDA House Shaml Road Peshawar against non-refundable amount of Rs. 2000/- on any working day during office hours till a day earlier from the opening of the RFP. Original Receipt of purchase of RFP documents should be attached with the bid.

7. There will be no sale of tender documents on the date of opening of tender.
