Sub: Violation of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rules 2014, Deputy Director (Safe City Project Hayatabad), PDA, Peshawar's Expression of Interest Notice for Hiring of a Security Company for Providing Security Services.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to PDA, Peshawar's EOI Notice, published in daily "The News" on 25th March, 2016. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the KPPRA Rules 2014.

As per advertisement, no EOI document is issued for applicants. However, according to KPPRA 2014, Rule No.25, the 'Expression of Interest' clause, clearly states that it should provide evaluation criteria for short-listing. The Rules is quoted below for your reference;

25. Expression of interest (EOI).--(1) A request for expression of interest shall be advertised, giving to the applicants at least two weeks for national competition and four weeks for international competition to submit their interest to provide consultancy services.

(2) The expression of interest shall contain at least the following information:

(a) the name and address of procuring entity;

(b) an appropriate description of the assignment providing scope of the intellectual and professional services required;


(c) deadline and place of the submission of expression of interest; and

(d) criteria for short-listing where required.

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 54, with request to re-invite the EOI under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

Supervisors (Ex-servicemen category only)

Assistant Security Officer (ASO) (Ex-servicemen category only)

Assignment Managers/Site Managers (Ex-servicemen category only)

B) The interested companies/firms are required to submit their EOI submitting the following details/information/documents:

- a. Company/firm profile/history
- b. Registration of firm/memorandum and articles of association.
- c. Certificate/undertaking for not having any litigation against PDA.
- d. Detail of permanent employees and their experience. Number of armed guards registered with the company is to be provided.
- e. Refresher training last schedule and frequency.
- f. Last three years evidence of income tax returns filed.
- g. Valid license of ministry of interior and KP government to run security company.
- h. Registration with income tax authorities KP government for sales tax, EOBI & ESSLI.
- i. Description of fire arms/weapons with documentary proof of arms license.
- j. Last three years bank statements and certificates
- k. NOC from the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa government.
- l. Audited financial statements for the last three years.
- m. Certificate of background checks by Special branch.
- n. Clientele list with telephone numbers of the contact persons.
- o. Contract may be extended for a period of two years on an annual basis & mutually agreed terms and conditions subject to satisfactory services rendered by the company.
- p. Have maximum professional security specialists (Ex defence) on their panel as indirect employees/management staff and the third party guards .
- q. Capability to provide maximum ex-servicemen from local areas as per company policy with extensive demonstrated knowledge of existing environmental conditions.
- r. Ability to develop logistics capability for security services, patrolling and quick reaction teams integrated with the static grid.
- s. Sufficient resources (financial & manpower) with professional management, organization and business support to deliver the required services.
- t. Have a training facility for the guards .
- u. Security companies able to provide licensed AK-47 weapon.

Interested security Firm/ Companies are invited to provide above mentioned information indicating that they are qualified to perform the required services. Security firms/ companies will be selected accordance with the KPPRA rules. Interested security firm/company may obtain further information at the given address during the normal office hours from 9.00 AM to 4.00 PM. Expression of Interest shall be submitted in sealed envelope, delivered through registered mail to the undersigned by 11th April, 2016 up to 4.00 pm & be clearly marked on the top of the envelope "Expressions of Interest for providing security services for Safe City Hayatabad Project". EOI Proposal will be opened on 12th April, 2016 at 12.00 pm. One company/ firm will not be allowed to submit more than one EOI. The procuring entity reserves the right to accept or reject all EOI. Late submitted EOI shall be rejected & returned unopened.
