
Kindly refer to the communication resting with this office vide your letter number TL17/2403/3A dated 24/03/2017 (copy Attached) and to state that the violation indicated by your esteemed organization is mis-interpreted and misplaced as the Procuring Entity reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity of goods to a certain percentage under SBDs duly notified by KPPRA. The relevant clause is reproduced as under:

29. Procuring agency's Right to Vary Quantities at Time of Award

29.1 "The Procuring agency reserves the right at the time of contract award to increase or decrease, by the percentage indicated in the Bid Data Sheet, the quantity of goods and services originally specified in the Schedule of Requirements without any change in unit price or other terms and conditions."

This office would, however, abide by the observations raised and would keep the quantity intact and highly appreciate the close coordination and efforts for bringing in transparency in the procurement process.

Sub: Violation of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rules 2014, Program Manager, Malaria Control Program, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa's Tender Notice for Purchase of Miscellaneous Items.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to Malaria Control Program, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa's Tender Notice, published in daily "Mashriq" on 22nd March, 2017. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the KPK Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rules 2014.

As per advertisement, "Quantity of the items can increased/ decreased", whereas any change in tender conditions, specifications and quantity after bid opening by procuring agency is not allowed under Rules. However, according to KPPRA Rules 2014, Rule No.10, repeat orders cannot exceed more than 15% of the original quantity. Stated as under;

10. Alternate methods for procurement of goods.--- A procurement entity may use the following alternative methods for procurement of goods, namely:

(c) a procurement entity shall only engage in alternate method if the following conditions exist, namely:


(i) repeat orders within a period of six months:

Provided that it does not exceed fifteen percent of the original contract value;

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 54, with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

1. Integrated Vector Control / Malaria Control Program Khyber Pakhtunkhwa invites sealed bids under National Competitive Bidding from reputed national and international manufacturers/importers for procuring high quality items for the financial year 2016-17.
2. Bidding shall be conducted through Single Stage-Two Envelopes Bidding Procedure comprising a single package containing two envelopes as per KPPRA Rules-2014. Each envelope shall contain separately technical and financial bid clearly marked in bold & legible letters. The firms are bound to provide complete information of the bidder along with its postal as well as valid email address and phone number/s on each of the respective envelope.
3. Bidding documents, detailed description and quantities of items, can be obtained from Malaria Control Program office, 16-A Tatara Road, Rahat Abad Near Peshawar University during office hours till 07/04/2017, and application form must be obtained from the office against the non-refundable cash payment of Pak Rupees One thousand (Rs. 1000/-PKR). The Bidding Documents can also be downloaded from the official website www.healthkp.gov.pk
4. A pre bid meeting will be held on 31/03/2017, at 10:00 AM, at Conference Room of Directorate General Health Services KPK, Khyber Road, Peshawar. The bidders are required to thoroughly study the Standard Bidding Documents before the pre bid meeting for any clarification of their queries during the said meeting.
5. The bids shall reach to the Office of the undersigned through registered Dak or Courier Services on or before 07/04/2017 at 11.00AM, which shall be opened on the same day by the Procurement committee in the presence of Representatives of the bidders who chose to attend at 11:30 AM in conference room, office of the DGHS, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. Bid submitted after due date & time shall not be entertained.
6. The Bid must be accompanied with Bid Security @ 2% of the total bid value in the shape of Pay Order (PO) / Demand Draft (DD) or Call Deposit Receipt (CDR), in the name of the undersigned.
7. The bidders shall submit an undertaking on stamp paper in their Technical Bids to be effect that the requisite Bid Security is included in their Financial Bid (But not showing the exact value of CDR). Late bids OR BIDs received after due date and time will be treated as non-responsive.
8. Quantity of the items can be increased / decreased.
9. Bids must be valid upto 30 June 2017.
10. Bidders are required to offer their most competitive lowest rate of their items inclusive of all the taxes, as negotiations on quoted rates are not allowed under the rules. The bid must be valid up to 30 June 2017.
11. The undersigned reserves the right to reject all or any the bids as per provisions contained in Rule 47 of KPPRA Rules 2014.
