Sub: Violation of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rules 2014, Project Director, Safe Blood Transfusion Project, Hayatabad Medical Complex, Peshawar's Tender Notice for Procuring Consumables and Disposable Items.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to Safe Blood Transfusion Project, HMC, Peshawar's Tender Notice published in daily "Mashriq" on 29th December, 2015. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the KPPRA Rules 2014.

As per advertisement, "Quantity of the items can be increased/ decreased", whereas any change in tender conditions, specifications and quantity after bid opening by procuring agency is not allowed under Rules and Supreme Court orders. However, according to KPK Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rules 2014, Page 6 & 7, repeat orders cannot exceed more than 15% of the original quantity. Stated as under;

Alternate methods for procurement of goods.--- A procurement entity may use the following alternative methods for procurement of goods, namely:

(c) a procurement entity shall only engage in alternate method if the following conditions exist, namely:

(i) repeat orders within a period of six months:

Provided that it does not exceed fifteen percent of the original contract value;

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement, mentioned KPPRA Rules 2014, page 22 stated as under; and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

Mis-procurement.--- Any breach of these rules shall amount to mis-procurement and the person responsible for such breach shall be liable to be proceeded under the relevant law.

Sealed Bids are invited from highly reputed national, international manufactures and authorized/sole agents for procuring good quality consumables and disposable items to meet requirement of the Regional Blood Transfusion Centre Peshawar. The bids should reach to office of the undersigned upto 18/01/2016 at 09.30 am and shall be opened on the same date at 11.00 am in presence of representative of the firms. The bids shall be opened in office of the Director General Health Services Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar. In case of public holiday on closing date, the bids shall be opened on next working day.

Terms & Conditions

1. Estimated Cost is Rs.14.000 million
2. The rates approved will remain effective till 30/06/2016.
3. Bidding documents, detailed description and quantities of items can be obtained at cost of Rs.500/- from the undersigned during office hours.
4. Only typed tender on original prescribing letter pad sealed & signed (Every Page) should be submitted, hand written tender would not be accepted.
5. The eligible firms should submit the bid security in shape of Cash Deposit Receipt (CDR) equal to 2% of their bid amount.
6. Late bids will be treated as non-responsive.
7. Samples of the quoted items should be produced by bidders before the selection when asked in case of failure, the bid will not be considered.
8. The Bidders are requested to give their price inclusive of all taxes & duties.
9. The taxes will be deducted as per government rules.
10. The supplier will be bound to ensure the supply of the said order within 30 days for local items and 90 days for imported items on receipt of order otherwise 2% penalty per day will be imposed and supply will be made on risk and cost of the supplier.
11. The Bidders are requested to give their best and final price for the quoted items as per specifications as no negotiations on the price are allowed. Quantity of items can be increased / decreased.
12. The envelopes shall be marked as "FINANCIAL PROPOSAL" and "TECHNICAL PROPOSAL" in bold and legible letters to avoid confusion. The Bidder shall seal both the proposals/bids in separate envelopes. The said two envelopes should be sealed in an outer envelope.
