Sub: Violation of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rules 2014,
Hospital Director, Medical Teaching Institute, Lady Reading Hospital, Peshawar's EOI Notice (2nd
Tender) Hiring of Consultation Firm for Strengthening of IT Infrastructure.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to Medical Teaching Institute, Lady Reading Hospital, Peshawar's EOI Notice (2nd
Tender) published in daily "Jang" on 2nd October, 2015. It is observed that the advertisement is in
violation of the KPPRA Rules 2014.

As per advertisement, "no evaluation criteria for short-listing are mentioned for applicants". However,
according to KPPRA Rules 2014, Page 14 & Page 18, the 'Expression of Interest' clause, clearly states
that it should provide evaluation criteria for short-listing. Stated as under;

*Expression of interest (EOI).--(1) A request for expression of interest shall be advertised,
giving to the applicants at least two weeks for national competition and four weeks for
international competition to submit their interest to provide consultancy services.*

(2) The expression of interest shall contain at least the following information:

(a) the name and address of procuring entity;

*(b) an appropriate description of the assignment providing scope of the intellectual and
professional services required;*

(c) deadline and place of the submission of expression of interest; and

(d) criteria for short-listing where required.

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement, mentioned KPPRA
Rules 2014, page 22 stated as under; and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed
procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

*Mis-procurement. – Any breach of these rules shall amount to mis-procurement and the
person responsible for such breach shall be liable to be proceeded under the relevant law.*

5. Income tax, registration number and returns, GST payments certificate, etc.
6. Firms should submit a comprehensive technical proposal in English (One original & One Copy) and a financial proposal (One original & two copies) in Separate and Sealed envelopes.
7. 2% bid security should be deposited in the name of Hospital Director, MTI Lady Reading Hospital Peshawar and submitted in the Financial proposal.
8. The Technical Bid should have, on stamp paper, an affidavit that CDR @ 2% of the bid is attached with Financial Bid.
9. The CDR must be from the Bank of Khyber; however, this condition will not be mandatory where the Bank of Khyber is having no branch within reasonable distance.
10. The Scope of work can be obtained from the Purchase & Procurement Cell, MTI LRH.
11. Last date of submission of proposal 20th October 2015 at 11:00 AM. The Technical bids will be opened on the same day at 11.30 am in presence of the representatives of the concerned firms.
12. The successful bidder will be bound to execute agreement on stamp paper.
13. The competent authority has the right to reject all bids under Rule 47 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (KPPRA) Procurement Rules 2014.
