Sub: Violation of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rules 2014, Director General, Project Coordination Unit (PCU), Police Department KPK, Peshawar's Re-E-Tender Notice for F/S, Development and Construction Works.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to PCU, Police Department KPK, Peshawar's Re-E-Tender Notice, published in daily "Mashriq" on 4th March, 2016. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the KPPRA Rules 2014.


As per advertisement, the Tender form can be downloaded till 14th March, 2016, which means bidding documents are not available for the bidders till the submission date, i.e, 17th March, 2016. The rule "Response Time" includes purchase of bidding documents for the bidder from the date of publishing of advertisement till the date of submission of bids. Therefore, the advertisement is in violation of KPPRA Rules 2014, Rule No.34 (1). Stated as under:

34. Response time.---(1) The procuring entity may decide the response time for receipt of bids or proposals including proposals for pre-qualification from the date of publication of an advertisement or notice, keeping in view the contract's complexity, and urgency. However, under no circumstances the response time shall be less than fifteen days for national competitive bidding and thirty days for international competitive bidding from the date of publication of advertisement or notice in the national newspaper.

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 54, with request to re-invite the e-tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

- Tender form can be downloaded from the date of appearance of the advertisement in the press till 14-03-2016 from the official website of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Police www.kppolice.gov.pk the same may also be obtained from the office of undersigned.
- The eligible contractors/firms are required to submit two separate sealed envelopes i.e. one envelope containing technical information of the contractor clearly marked as technical bid comprised by information as including in instructions to bidders, while the second envelope containing priced BOQ, clearly marked as Financial Bid, shall be accompanied with Earnest money/bid security @ 2% of Bid Cost including stamp duty in favor of the Director General PCU, Police Department Peshawar in shape of Call Deposit from any scheduled bank of Pakistan.
- The bidders are required to send their bids (technical and financial) through courier and shall reach to the office of undersign before closing date and time.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

- The "Technical Bid" of the Firm /Contractor will be evaluated in accordance with evaluation criteria as per PEC/KPPRA standards included in the bidding documents, comprises of the following documents:
 - An affidavit is required to be provided in the Technical bid regarding attachment of the call deposit in the financial bid
 - Detail of projects of similar nature under taken by the firm in the last 05 years (in-hand/completed) supported by documentary evidence such as work order/completion report.
 - Registration with PEC and enlistment with C & W Department for the CFY 2015-16.
 - Financial status, Bank Balance & Certificate from the schedule Bank for the last 3 years.
 - The Income Tax certificate from the Department showing Tax Payment regarding works/ project executed during last 05 years.
 - Detail of required T&P machinery available with the contractors.
 - Detail of Technical Staff for the proposed project, duly supported by attested credentials.
- Financial bid should include priced BOQ (hand written in figures and words) and bid security.
- Bidding shall be carried out on "Item Rate System". Wherein the Bidder are required to fill their own rates / amount in the blank columns against each item in the BOQ. In case no rate is quoted against any item, the same will be executed at free of cost by the contractor, as per specifications/drawings. Furthermore, two decimal digits will be considered for evaluation.
- The "Financial Bids" of only Technically qualified bidders will be opened in the presence of bidders / their representatives, who may like to attend, in the office of the Director General, PCU Police Department Peshawar, House No.10 National Bank Colony, Warsak Road Peshawar, whereas the Financial Bids of Technically non responsive Bidders shall be returned unopened to the respective contractors.
- The person whose name exists in form-H/Partnership deed will only be entitled to sign the tender, BOQ and all other contract documents.
- In case of the successful bid is below the engineer estimate up to 10% the bidder shall provide performance guarantee/insurance coverage of a company having at least AA rating from PACRA/JCR or bank guarantee equal to 10% of estimated cost within 21 days of acceptance letter. In case the bid is more than 10% below the engineer estimate, the bidder shall provide bank guarantee as additional security within 14 days equal to the amount of the difference of the quoted bid and the engineer estimate to firm up the bid. These guarantees will be discharged on expiry of the defect liability period of the contract.
- If the performance bond or bank guarantee (which ever the case maybe) is not provide by the bidder in the required period, the offer will be given the next lowest bidder & so on and the bid security of the bidder will be forfeited.
- In case of equal bid 1st, 2nd and 3rd etc, the lowest bidder would be decided through toss/ draw.
- Any item not reflected in the Bill of Quantities (BOQ) and required at the site, shall be paid in accordance with MRS, 2015, subject to prior approval of the competent authority.
- Bids will be valid for 90 days from the date of acceptance by the competent authority.
- Successful bidder should sign the agreement with the Department within seven (07) days acceptance of bid.
- Incomplete/disfiguring/over-writing/by-hand/delayed bids will be considered non-responsive.
- Any bidder who provides incorrect information should be disqualified.
- The bidder are liberty to seek any clarification or further information from the office of undersigned, if desire on any working day during office hours.
- The procuring entity may reject all bids or proposals at any time prior to the acceptance of a bid or proposals. The procurement entity shall upon request communicate to any contractor who submitted a bid or proposal; the ground for rejection of all bids or proposals as per KPPRA 47(1).
- A complete set of bidding documents may be purchased from the date of appearance of advertisement in the press till 14-03-2016 on submission of written application from the consultant office M/S Allied Engineering Consultants, Usmania Street Warsak Road Peshawar, Phone NO.091-5200283.
