SUB:- VIOLATION OF PUBLIC PROCUREMENT RULES 2004 BY M/S. CHINA  
INTERNATIONAL WATER & ELECTRIC CORPORATION (CWE).

I am directed to refer to your letter No. F.1(101)/DD-II/PPRA/2010 dated 16-07-2010, on the above subject and to state as under:-

1. As regard incorrectness of letter of 02-07-2008 issued by Chief Inspector (Stamps) KPT has no comment. The concerned office may inquire within department to ascertain its correctness and subsequently proceed in accordance with its findings. KPT has co-operated as far possible. However, it should not be ignored that the letter was issued in response to the contractor's request for exemption, which must have been recorded at concerned office. However, the issuance of above letter was not the final action in the matter. Based on the above letter other office of Government of Sindh prepared a challan i.e. Assistant Superintendent of Stamp. If the letter was fake why was the challan prepared, it all needs to be inquired within Government of Sindh.
  2. It was prime responsibility of Government of Sindh to correctly calculate and prepare challan to collect revenue in their own and national interest. Since not only the letter of 02-07-2008 was issued by Chief Inspector Stamp but challan was also issued by Asstt. Superintendent Stamp (copy attached along with bank's stamp) which points towards the orderliness of document, as the bank accepts only the challans issued by the concerned department. KPT has neither collected the amount of stamp fee nor deposited the same and also was not responsible or involved in all this process and exemption etc.
  3. Fixing stamp on each page of contract was carried out by Government of Sindh. This should have not been done if there was a doubt in the authenticity of the letter of 02-07-2008. As the challan was prepared for an amount mentioned on the letter, it implies that the letter was considered correct at the revenue collection office.
  4. The application of the "Integrity Pact" would only be possible if the firm's connivance with certain individual in Government of Sindh is established without any doubt, please.
