Sub: TIP letter to KPT dated 24 December 2012

Dear Sir,

As directed by its Chairman, Transparency International Pakistan has reexamined the case on which a complaint was written by the Chairman to KPT on 24th December 2012.

Record shows that on this very issue, last year on 29 November 2011, on KPT's requested Transparency International Pakistan for certain clarifications.

Transparency International Pakistan after going through the documents provided by KPT including the Implementation Agreement of KICT (sponsored by HPH Hong Kong who are also sponsors of Pakistan Deep Water Container Port PDWCP), Amendment Agreement of KICT 2006 and Implementation Agreement of PICT, had written a letter to KPT on 24th December 2011.

Vide this letter TIP has given detailed observations and views on the four questions of KPT, in light of legal opinions of KPT legal advisers Nafees Siddiqui law Associates dated 30.6.2005, Syed Shariffudin Pirzada dated 6/3/2004, Barrister Kazim Hussain dated 6/1/2003 and Cabinet Division Notification No. 2/1/2008 and PPRA-RA-III dated 7th May 2008.

Transparency International Pakistan recommends that the matter be dealt by KPT strictly in accordance with the law, PPRA-RA-III dated 7th May 2008 and keeping in view the legal opinions of Syed Shariffudin Pirzada, Nafees Siddiqui law Associates and Barrister Kazim Hussain.
