Dear Sir,

Refer our letter dated 6<sup>th</sup> September 2010 on the above subject. As you have informed that this project will be funded by IBRD, World Bank guidelines of May 2010 are applicable.

In such a case if the Govt. of Pakistan has not asked the World Bank to adopt PPRA Rules for this project NO P112902 for the best reason known to them, the World Bank guideline will supersede PPRA ordinance 2002.

We request Karachi Port Trust, Ministry of Finance and Economic Affairs Division to kindly try that in all foreign loans PPRA Rules 2004 should be adopted.

These rules are more transparent than any of the IFI rules and more suitable for conditions prevailing in Pakistan.
