This is with regard to above tender for which a meeting was also held at your office, on your request, in which KW & SB and Consultants of K-IV project were also present.

It was agreed that the evaluation of tenders according to the Scope of Work of contract is the responsibility of Consultants, and KW & SB did not act on the contract agreement signed with the Consultants, on the pretext that SPPRA Rules do not allow.

Transparency International Pakistan after the discussion agreed that the evaluation of these tenders shall be entrusted to consultants, to comply with the duties entrusted to consultants, who are appointed especially to carry out all the evaluation of all the tenders in K-IV Project.

Transparency International Pakistan has not received the minutes of meeting nor the evaluation report by the Consultant yet, although SPPRA was reminded twice.

The clarification by KW & SB vide its letter dated 22nd June, 2015 to SPPRA, forwarded to TI-Pakistan on 01.07.2015 by Mr. Aijaz Ali Laghari, Manager (Grievances), received in the afternoon of 08.07.2015, confirms that KW & SB has violated SPPRA Rules, Scope of Work of Contract of the Consultants.

The evaluation report of the consultants is still awaited.

Transparency International Pakistan is striving for across the board application of Rule of Law, which is the only way to stop corruption.
