Sub: Violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004, Project Director, National Forensic
Science Agency Project, Ministry of Interior, Islamabad's Tender Notice for Supply of
Miscellaneous Items.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to National Forensic Science Agency Project, Ministry of Interior, Islamabad's Tender Notice, published in the "Dawn" on 8th January, 2016. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the Public Procurement Rules 2004.

As per the advertisement, "Quantity of the items mentioned can be increased/decreased", whereas any change in tender conditions, specifications and quantity after bid opening by procuring agency is not allowed under Rules. However according to Public Procurement Rules 2004, Rule No. 42 (c) (iv), repeat orders cannot exceed more than 15% of the original quantity. Stated as under;

42. Alternative methods of procurements.- A procuring agency may utilize the following alternative methods of procurement of goods, services and works, namely:-

(c) direct contracting: a procuring agency shall only engage in direct contracting if any of the following conditions exist:

(iv) repeat orders not exceeding fifteen per cent of the original procurement;

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 50, and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.
