Dear Sir,

This is with reference to TI-Pakistan's letter dated 3rd August 2013 (Copy enclosed), sent to the Federal Minister for Ports & Shipping, regarding Irregularities committed in the Dredging Contract by M/s China International Water and Electric Co. Ltd. Also reminder was sent on 16th September 2013 (Copy enclosed), however no reply has been received even after a lapse of 5.5 month.

Transparency International Pakistan, vide its above mentioned letter, had forwarded a complaint, against KPT that KPT is not taking action against the Dredging Contract by M/s China International Water and Electric Co. Ltd (CWE) to deduct the liquidated damages w.e.f. March 2013, imposed by the Consultants.

The Minister is again requested to look into the complaint, and if found to be correct, direct KPT to raise genuine claims against M/s CWE, and also take action according to rules and procedures against all.

Transparency International Pakistan is striving for across the board application of Rule of Law, which is the only way to stop corruption.
