Dear Sir,

Transparency International Pakistan has received a complaint from Mr. Mubbashir Iqbal, who is the resident of District Sahiwal against the unavailability of wireless phone at Jhaal railroad crossing No. 140, district Sahiwal. The detailed complaint is enclosed for your ready reference and is self-explanatory.

The complainant alleges that the Jhaal railroad crossing is a very busy one, and some 14 trains cross daily, but the only wireless system available at this crossing has been sent to the Okara railway station for maintenance two years ago. He further alleges that, now the *phattak* is closed after physically watching the trains because there is no other alternative available.

Transparency International Pakistan would greatly appreciate if you would kindly look into this matter, and if found genuine/correct take appropriate action to resolve this potentially dangerous matter.
