Sub: Violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004, For Divisional Superintendent, Pakistan Railways, Karachi's Tender Notice for Provision of Vehicles.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to Pakistan Railways, Karachi's Tender Notice published in daily "The News" on 31st January, 2018. It is observed that the advertisements are in violation of the PPRA Rules 2004.

1. As per advertisement, the bidder shall submit 10 % as bid security, which is violation of PPRA Rules 2004, Rule 25. Stated as under;

25. Bid security. - The procuring agency may require the bidders to furnish a bid security not exceeding five per cent of the bid price.

2. Also, "Administration reserves the right to reject all the bids without assigning any reason". It is not complying with PPRA Rules 2004, Rule No. 33, which requires that reason should be communicated to bidders. Stated as under:

33. Rejection of bids:- (1) The procuring agency may reject all bids or proposals at any time prior to the acceptance of a bid or proposal. The procuring agency shall upon request communicate to any supplier or contractor who submitted a bid or proposal, the grounds for its rejection of all bids or proposals, but is not required to justify those grounds.

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding the mis-procurement charge under Rule No 50, and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.
