Sub: Violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004, DME for Divisional Superintendent, Pakistan Railways, Sukkur's Tender Notice for Supply Speedo Meter.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to DME for Divisional Superintendent, Pakistan Railways, Sukkur's Tender Notice, published in the "Dawn" on 30th November, 2015. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the Public Procurement Rules 2004.

1. As per the advertisement, it is mentioned that "The competent authority has the right to reject any offer without assigning any reason". It is a violation of PPRA Rules 2004, Rule No.33 (1). Stated as under;

33. Rejection of bids. - (1) The procuring agency may reject all bids or proposals at any time prior to the acceptance of a bid or proposal. The procuring agency shall upon request communicate to any supplier or contractor who submitted a bid or proposal, the grounds for its rejection of all bids or proposals, but is not required to justify those grounds.

2. Also, it is stated that "The competent authority has the right to modify quantity." Any change in tender conditions, specifications and quantity after bid opening by procuring agency is not allowed under Rules. However according to Public Procurement Rules 2004, Rule No. 42 (c) (iv), repeat orders cannot exceed more than 15% of the original quantity. Stated as under;

42. Alternative methods of procurements.- A procuring agency may utilize the following alternative methods of procurement of goods, services and works, namely:-

(c) direct contracting: a procuring agency shall only engage in direct contracting if any of the following conditions exist:

(iv) repeat orders not exceeding fifteen per cent of the original procurement;

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding mis-procurement charge under Rule No 50, and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.
