Sub: Allegation of Violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004 by M/s Nespak in '6, 600 MW Power Park Project at Gaddani Balochistan, Pakistan in Package 1, Leveling and Grading'.

Dear Madam,

This is with reference to Transparency International Pakistan's letter dated 24th June, 2014, sent to the Secretary, Ministry of Water and Power, on the cited subject. However no reply has been received till date.

Transparency International Pakistan, vide its above mentioned letter, had forwarded a complaint of allegation of PPRA violation in the processing of award of contract in Leveling and Grading in Gaddani, Power Park Project by M/s NESPAK.

The complainant has raised serious objections on the role of M/s Nespak, and alleged that its officers are violating Public Procurement Rules 2004.

Transparency International Pakistan has examined the complaint and prima facie the allegations of the complaint seem to be correct as this procurement may be declared as mis- procurement.

The Secretary is again requested to kindly examine the issue raised, and if she also determines fault in the tendering process, the tender may be scraped and re-invited, and all those responsible are to be made accountable for these violations.

Transparency International Pakistan is striving for across the board application of Rule of Law, which is the only way to stop corruption.
