Transparency International Pakistan refers to its letters dated 31st December, 2018 and 30th January, 2019 and has again received a complaint dated 14th Feb, 2019 regarding the above procurement. The complainant has alleged that NBP is requiring prospective bidders to sign a non-disclosure form before issuing of tender documents.

We reiterate that the non-disclosure clause should be required to be signed by the successful bidder so that any information that he may come across during the implementation of the project may not be disclosed to anyone. A condition for the successful bidder to sign the non-disclosure may be included in the bidding documents.

Transparency International Pakistan is striving for across the board application of Rule of Law, which is the only way to stop corruption.
