
Transparency International Pakistan refers to its letter dated 23-2-2014 and again a reminder sent on 28-4-2014 on the complaint received against NBP irregularities, causing over Rs 9 Billion in Bangladesh NBP Branch, PPRA violation in purchase of Lexu Bullet Proof Vehicle at over Rs 40 Million, and evasion of income tax from NBP officers' salaries.

Unfortunately no response in seven months has been received on these complaints.

The President under the Article 19-A of the Constitution of Pakistan is requested to kindly inform TI-Pakistan whether the three complaints are correct or not, and if they are correct what measures have been taken to rectify them, and recover the tax payers money.
