Subject: **DEVELOPMENT OF NEW UPFRONT SOLAR PV TARIFF FOR 2016**

NEPRA in exercise of its powers under section 7 of the Regulation of Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Electric Power Act, 1997 and rule 3 (1) of the NEPRA (Tariff Standards and Procedure) Rules, 1998 read with regulation 3 of the NEPRA Upfront Tariff (Approval & Procedure) Regulations, 2011 has decided to initiate suo motu proceedings to determine a new upfront solar tariff for 2016 for generation of electricity from solar PV power projects. Notice of proceedings along with salient features of the proposed upfront tariff has been published in the national newspapers on September 19, 2015 (copy attached) inviting comments /intervention requests from stakeholders, interested/affected persons and the general public.

Where any statement in an affidavit given as per paragraph above is stated to be true according to the information received by the deponent, the affidavit shall also disclose the source of such information.
