VIOLATION OF PUBLIC PROCUREMENT RULES 2004, MILITARY ENGINEER SERVICES, PAKISTAN NAVY TENDER NOTICE FOR CONST OF NON-RESIDENTIAL WORK AT KARACHI

Reference:

A. Your letter No. Nil dated 12 May'2011

In response to your letter at reference, following clarifications are forwarded herewith for your information and satisfaction, please: -

- a. Advertisement given in newspapers is just for calling applications for pre-qualification of contractors.
- b. On receipt of applications for pre-qualification from different contractors, tenders are being issued to qualified contractors (minimum 6 x tenders as per rules) with date of issue and opening having margin of 7-15 days as per notice of tender (copy attached). However it is confirmed that tenders have not been issued so far to give the maxim time for receipt of applications.
- c. Besides PPRA rules, orders/instructions of Military Engineer Services department are also being followed.
- d. Half yearly/yearly local/test audit is also being carried out through controller local Audit Lahore as well as DG Audit Defence Services for tendering process to ensure transparent procedure.

LUMP SUM AND MEASUREMENT CONTRACTS

A lump sum/measurement tender is invited for _____

1. The work is estimated to cost Rs _____ This estimate, however, is not a guarantee and is merely given as a rough guide and if the work actually costs more or loss, it will not be made a cause of claim of any sort.
2. The work is to be completed within **(12) Twelve** months from a date specified in the first written work order.
3. Contractors who are enlisted with MES in category **'D' Rs.72000/-** and above may only apply.
4. Contractors who are enlisted with other departments like Central/Provincial PWD, KDA, CDA, PWR, WAPDA etc. may also tender provided that they are approved contractors of such, department with the tendering limit of **Rs.5.000 (M)** And above Such contractors will furnish the following information along with their applications for issue of tender :-
 - k. proof of their enlistment in the specified tendering limit
 - l. List of works executed by them, indicating nature, value, locations and the name of concerned department for each of such works.
 - m. List of moveable and immovable assets owned by the applicant, duly supported by certificates from Bank and Revenue Authorities respectively.
 - n. List of tools and plant, shuttering etc. owned by him
 - o. Any other relevant information which may support the suitability of the applicant for the work
5. Contractors not enlisted with MES shall deposit Rs. _____ equal to 2% of the estimated value of the contract amount as earnest money in Government Treasury or any Scheduled Bank of Pakistan in favour of **CMES (Navy) Comcoast Karachi** and the Treasury receipt/Bank receipt will be sent along with the application.

The earnest money shall be refunded to the contractor if his tender is not accepted and after he has returned all the documents issued to him. In case of acceptance of tender, the earnest money deposited by the contractor shall be adjusted as part of security to be deposited by him (See para-8)

Irrespective of what is said before, the earnest money shall be liable to be forfeited in the case of a contractor who submits a non-bonafide tender, for which the decision of accepting officer shall be final and binding.
