Sub: Violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004, Pakistan Navy, Military Engineering Services (MES), Islamabad's Pre-qualification/Tender Notice for Refurbishment, Construction & Repair/ Maintenance Work.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to Pakistan Navy, Military Engineering Services (MES), Islamabad's Pre-qualification/Tender Notice, published in the "News" on 24<sup>th</sup> February, 2014. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the Public Procurement Rules 2004.


As per the advertisement 15 days of response time is not given for submission of applications for Pre-qualification Notice, and is 3 days short, which is a mandatory requirement of Public Procurement Rules 2004, Rule No.13 (1), stated as under:

*13. Response time.- (1) The procuring agency may decide the response time for receipt of bids or proposals (including proposals for pre-qualification) from the date of publication of an advertisement or notice, keeping in view the individual procurement's complexity, availability and urgency. However, under no circumstances the response time shall be less than fifteen days for national competitive bidding and thirty days for international competitive bidding from the date of publication of advertisement or notice.*

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding the mis-procurement charge under Rule No 50, and with request to re-invite the tender under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.
