Sub: Violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004, HQ DW&CE (Navy), Pakistan Navy, Islamabad's Pre-Qualification Notice of Consultant Military Engineering Services.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to Pakistan Navy, Islamabad's Pre-Qualification Notice, published in daily "Dawn" on 25th December, 2014. It is observed that the advertisement is in violation of the Public Procurement Rules 2004.

As per advertisement no pre-qualification documents is issued for the bidders, whereas according to Rule No. 16 (1) (2) it is mandatory to provide a set of prequalification document, and provide detail evaluation criteria to applicants. The Rule is quoted below for your information;

16. Pre-qualification process.- (1) *The procuring agency engaging in pre-qualification shall announce, in the pre-qualification documents, all information required for pre-qualification including instructions for preparation and submission of the pre-qualification documents, evaluation criteria, list of documentary evidence required by suppliers or contractors to demonstrate their respective qualifications and any other information that the procuring agency deems necessary for pre-qualification.*

(2) *The procuring agency shall provide a set of pre-qualification documents to any supplier or contractor, on request and subject to payment of price, if any.*

Also, as per PPRA letter No. F.2 (9)/DD-II/PPRA/2009 issued by Managing Director PPRA, prequalification document should be provided in the selection of bidders. (Copy Attached)

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding the mis-procurement charge under Rule No 50, and with request to re-invite the Pre-Qualification Notice under the prescribed procedures or issue a corrigendum and extend date accordingly.

PRE-QUALIFICATION OF CONSULTANT MILITARY ENGINEER SERVICES

Applications for pre-qualification of Consultants are invited by the **HQ DW&CE (Navy) E-8 Sector, Islamabad** up to **31 December 2014** from reputed consultants having vast experience in planning, surveying, designing, supervision, and evaluation of Marine Railways. Terms of Reference (ToR) issued to the pre-qualified firms/consultants will be required to submit their bid by **11:30 hours** on **22 January 2015** and shall be opened on the same date at **12:00 hours**:

1. The firms should be capable of offering following services:
 - a. Survey, field work, laboratory testing analytical modelling along with recommendations and proposal for refurbishment of Marine Railway.
 - b. Condition assessment to establish the existing condition of complete civil structure, mechanical and electrical machinery/equipment and their fittings in the Dock.
 - c. To ascertain the actual condition of all critical components of the facility in detail.
 - d. Review of design and drawings, supervision of refurbishment works, witness trials of marine railway system, inspection of stores / equipment and necessary advice in safety aspects of construction activities.
2. The following information should be provided:
 - a. Name and address with telephone and Fax Number of the Company/Firm along with Article and Memorandum of Association/Partnership deeds.
 - b. Photocopy of company's registration showing year of establishment.
 - c. List of Technical Key personnel with bio-data and their registration with the Pakistan Council of Architects and Town Planners and Pakistan Engineering Council.
 - d. List of similar types of job and other projects designed and completed by the company during the last ten years stating location, name of client, covered area and cost of the project.
 - e. List of similar type of jobs being presently executed together with other projects with location, estimated cost and expected date of completion and the name of the client.
 - f. Photocopy of income tax registration certificate.
 - g. Particulars of litigation/arbitration cases in which the firm may have been involved during the last ten years and result thereof.
 - h. Affidavit on non-judicial paper stating that the above-mentioned information is correct.
3. Director of Works & Chief Engineer (Navy) reserves the right to reject any or all the applications in the light of para-33 of PPRA rules-2004. Incomplete application shall not be entertained.
