Dear Sir,

1. It is submitted that applications were invited for pre-qualifications of firms / contractors upto 09 February 2016 by this HQ under Military Engineer Services tender notice for the subject work, published in daily "Nawaiwaqt" on 3rd February 2016.
2. It is clarified that seven days were given to the prospective firms/contractors for submission of applications for pre-qualifications and not for bidding purpose which has been misinterpreted at your end.
3. Bidding / tender documents were issued to pre-qualified firms / contractors on 11 Feb 2016 and opened on 25 Feb 2016 as already indicated in the above tender notice and in no case it will be less than 15 days.
4. In view of the above, it is submitted that no violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004 has been committed. Moreover this HQ always endeavors religiously to follow PPRA rules please.
