Subject: **Complaint against Corruption In National Police Foundation.**

Memorandum

Please refer to your letter No.938/181(1), dated 10th Nov. 2010 on the subject cited above.

2. The undersigned is directed to inform you that the factual position in this matter is that at the time of the establishment of the housing scheme E-11, Mr. Anjum Aqeel Khan M/S Land Linkers offered to affiliate 75-kanal land free of cost and requested to issue allotment letters as per list (List of 149 persons of affectees) subject to the condition transfer of land in the name of NPF. The NPF affiliated the land prepared a plan and issue allotment letters as per his request and handed over to him. Mr. Anjum Aqeel Khan transferred only 54-kanal, 14-Marlas land in the name of NPF and could not arrange 23-kanal land. The NPF authorities remained in touch Mr. Anjum Aqeel Khan M/S Land Linkers for the transfer of remaining land as the claimants could not get the plots.
3. The plot No.834 was allotted to one Mr. Jamil Qureshi whose name was mentioned at Serial No.128 in the list provided Mr. Anjum Aqeel Khan. Later on





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the same was transfer to applicant through attorney Mr. Amir Khan S/O Mr.Khuda Dad Khan (real brother of Mr.Anjum Aqeel Khan) vide registration No.1261 dated 13-11-2002 Book No.4, Volume No.395 page No.105 to 107 of Joint Sub-Registrar Islamabad.

4. The land of the plot falls in the area of affiliated land while Mr.Anjum Aqeel Khan has not provided the land as offered by him. Therefore, the plot No.834, which was situated in that area, could not be handed over to the applicant. The NPF is still making all out efforts to settle the matter. However, the NPF has not received a penny in lieu of the cost of the plot and facing problems.

5. The NPF can not hold any body responsible for this mischief. It is crystal clear that the allotment letters were issued on the request of Mr.Anjum Aqeel Khan in lieu of 75-kanal land, which was offered for affiliation with the NPF, but he could not honour his commitment.

6. It is pertinent to mention here to resolve the issue, NPF has allotted a plot No.876 measuring 166.66 Sq.Yards in lieu of plot No.834 measuring 166.66 Sq.Yards from NPF own land vide this office letter No.M/4242/E-11/3775 dated 11.11.2010, but the applicant refused to accept this offer vide letter dated 15-11-2010.

7. The report is submitted for perusal please.
