FOR EXTRACTION OF LPG AND NGL
FROM GAS OF NUR/BAGLA PLANT**

Oil & Gas Development Company Limited (OGDCL), the largest Exploration and Production listed Company of Pakistan seeks proposals from prospective Bidders or their representatives for extraction of LPG about 08-10 Metric Ton per day and NGL from 08 MMSCFD (Initially) dehydrated/treated gas comprising of less than 3 mole % CO₂ and maximum 7 lbs of water/MMSCF gas. OGDCL will pay processing fee for extraction of LPG and NGL to successful Bidder, whereas all recovered products and residual gas will be the property of OGDCL. The bidder is required to recompress the residual gas to meet the pressure requirement (1200 psig) of the Gas Transmission Company.

Gas would be available at the Nur/Bagla gas treatment Plant Battery limit by June 2012, which is located 01 Kms South East of Bagla Well (Latitude: 24° 34' 15.49" Longitude: 68° 25' 15.49" of the Bagla well) in district Thatta/Badin of Sindh Province. Bidder's facilities has to be ready as soon as possible for extraction of LPG and NGL by end June 2012. The installed plant should be state of art designed based for maximum recovery of LPG and NGL. Processing arrangement will be over the economic life of the field. In addition to LPG and NGL extraction facilities, bidders are also required to provide minimum of 05 days storage capacity of the products.

Sealed bids in duplicate for the above proposals are invited against the following Tender Enquiry under two envelope bidding procedure from those companies who are eligible and possess required capabilities for providing above services. Detailed terms and conditions and scope of work is mentioned in the tender documents.
