Dear Sir,

Transparency International Pakistan has received a complaint, dated 31st July 2013, from M/s Tariq Lime Merchants, against OGDCL for Illegal Tender Bidding for sale of Low Pressure Gas from Toot Oil Field, Tender Inquiry No. OGDCL/COMM/LP-GAS/841&842/2013.

The complainant has alleged that M/s Tariq Lime Merchants is already under an agreement for purchase of low pressure gas of toot oil field, whereas OGDCL has invited bids for same project and the bid opening is on 1st August 2013, and the complainant has secured a stay order from Honorable High Court Islamabad, on 27th July 2013 (Annex A), in regards to supply of low pressure gas from toot field.

Transparency International Pakistan request Managing Director of OGDCL, to kindly examine the complaint, and if it is found to be correct, kindly postponed the tender opening, as it will be a contempt of Court.

Transparency International Pakistan is striving for across the board application of Rule of Law, which is the only way to stop corruption.
