Sub: Violation of Sindh Public Procurement Rules, 2010
Invitation of Prequalification of Contractors at PAF Base Korangi

Dear Sir,

The invitation of expression of interest advertised in daily The News on 10-3-2011 is lacking transparency and violating the Public Procurement Rules, 2004.

According to Public Procurement Rules 2004 minimum 15 days are to be given to submit applications of prequalification from the date of publication of advertisement notice in press, **whereas you have only allowed 12 days time.**

13. Response time.-

**(1) The procuring agency may decide the response time for receipt of bids or proposals (including proposals for pre-qualification) from the date of publication of an advertisement or notice, keeping in view the individual procurement's complexity, availability and urgency. However, under no circumstances the response time shall be less than fifteen days for national competitive bidding and thirty days for international competitive bidding from the date of publication of advertisement or notice.*

All advertisements or notices shall expressly mention the response time allowed for that particular procurement along with the information for collection of bid documents which shall be issued till a given date, allowing sufficient time to complete and submit the bid by the closing date:

Second violation is of Rule No 16 and 17 which required PAF to provide documents, which is not mentioned in the Notice, which shall also include Evaluation Criteria..


16. Pre-qualification process.-

- (1) The procuring agency engaging in pre-qualification shall announce, in the pre-qualification documents, all information required for pre-qualification including instructions for preparation and submission of the pre-qualification documents, evaluation criteria, list of documentary evidence required by suppliers or contractors to demonstrate their respective qualifications and any other information that the procuring agency deems necessary for prequalification.*
- (2) The procuring agency shall provide a set of pre-qualification documents to any supplier or contractor, on request and subject to payment of price, if any.*



The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding the mis-procurement charge under Rule No 50, and to re-invite the tender, which shall be based on the procedures prescribed by Public Procurement Rules 2004.
