Sub: Violation of Public Procurement Rules, 2004
Invitation of / Tender for Certain Residential/Nos. Residential facilities at PN NN

Dear Sir,

The invitation of expression of interest advertised in daily The News on 10-3-2011 is lacking transparency and violating the Public Procurement Rules, 2004.

According to Public Procurement Rules 2004 minimum 15 days are to be given to submit applications from the date of publication of advertisement notice in press, **whereas you have only allowed 2 days time.**

13. Response time.-

**(1) The procuring agency may decide the response time for receipt of bids or proposals (including proposals for pre-qualification) from the date of publication of an advertisement or notice, keeping in view the individual procurement's complexity, availability and urgency. However, under no circumstances the response time shall be less than fifteen days for national competitive bidding and thirty days for international competitive bidding from the date of publication of advertisement or notice.*

All advertisements or notices shall expressly mention the response time allowed for that particular procurement along with the information for collection of bid documents which shall be issued till a given date, allowing sufficient time to complete and submit the bid by the closing date:

The above information is forwarded for the purpose of avoiding the mis-procurement charge under Rule No 50, and to re-invite the tender, which shall be based on the procedures prescribed by Public Procurement Rules 2004.

Contractors not born on the approved list of MES will furnish a proof certificate with their application for being on the appropriate list of the Department concerned, and Financial Statement with necessary bank certificate and previous experience, giving details and type of works executed in the last two years and works in hand on the Performa appended below duly attested by the competent authority of that Department. They will also furnish on CDR equivalent to 2% estimated cost.
