Subject: Allegations of Violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004 by M/S National Logistics Cell in Contracts of PQA- TI-P Letter dated 01st December 2011.

Dear Sir,

Please find attached copy of TI Pakistan's letter dated 01st December 2011, which had been sent to you earlier. As of date we have not received any reply.

Through its letter of 01st December 2011, TI-P had forwarded a complaint made to the Chief Justice of Pakistan against M/S National Logistic Cell stating that they are trying to get billions of rupees tender from PQA without open bidding.

TI-P had also mentioned that there is some information about M/S National Logistic Cell not abiding with the terms of the Contract and PPRA Rules as that Planning and Development Division has directed that M/S NLC are exempted from furnishing Performance Security and for all Advances and retention money vide letter dated 03/12/1985 and 29/06/2000.

It is to remind you that PPRA Ordinance 2002 and the Public Procurement Rules 2004 are the law of land, and that the Planning & Development Division has allegedly violated the Law and issue such instructions for the exemption to M/S NLC.

TI-Pakistan requests you to kindly reply to our letter and inform us about any rectification that has been done in this regard .
