Dear Sir,

Transparency International Pakistan is in receipt of PCP letter dated 31st July 2013, reference no.PCP.1-10/2013-P&D/6746, for vetting of draft advertisement alongwith Evaluation Criteria and Terms and Conditions for inviting tender for procurement of printing material.


The draft advertisement alongwith Evaluation Criteria and Terms and Conditions has been examined in detail, and point number 6 and 12 of terms and conditions, need to be revise as followed:

11. Bid security @ 2% of the bid price may be submitted alongwith the tender in shape of Demand Draft/Call Deposit/Pay Order, Bank / Insurance Guarantee from an insurance company having at least AA rating from PACRA/JCR, in favour of Printing Corporation of Pakistan (Pvt) Limited, Islamabad. However, already security money with PCP and receivable dues from PCP shall not be considered against bid money. Tender received without security bid will not be considered and will be rejected straightway.
12. TI-Pakistan refers to Rule 31 of Public Procurement Rules 2004 that any change in the bid is only allowed to the extent that the substance of bid is not affected. Therefore please eliminate point 12 from Terms and Condition, as it is in violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004.

Also add in terms and condition "PCP will place orders to the lowest bidders for each item separately".
