**Sub: Violation of MOU Signed between Pakistan International Airlines and
Transparency International - Pakistan.**

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to the tender for annual contract for the provisioning of fumigation services AT KHI, ISB, LHE, PEW and UET stations reference no. P&L/GM(CP&C)/Cont/081A/12.

TI-Pakistan has observed that the said tender was opened and without informing TI-Pakistan, which is a breach of MOU signed between PIA and TI-Pakistan.

TI-Pakistan refer to MOU clause B(3) "Transparency International Pakistan Role: In the Tender Opening. TIP expert will be a member of committees, only as Observer".

TI-Pakistan also refer to a complaint received dated 18th December 2012 against Tender no: P&L/GM(CP&C)/CONT/081A/12 for Annual contract for the procurement of fumigation services at KHI, ISB, LHE, PEW and UET Stations.


The complainant has alleged that the evaluation criterion was not followed by PIA and the lowest bidder was rejected without evaluation.

Transparency International Pakistan requests the MD to look into this matter, and if the allegations are correct, cancel and re-invite the tender according to Public Procurement Regularity Rules 2004.

TI-Pakistan and Pakistan International Airline are signatory of MOU dated 2012, for transparency in all procurements. Hence it is advised to PIA to execute all tendering process according to MOU.

Transparency International Pakistan is striving for across the board application of Rule of Law, which is the only way to stop corruption.
