Please find attached copy of TI Pakistan's letter dated 14<sup>th</sup> October 2011, which had been sent to you earlier.

TI-P had requested the Prime Minister to take notice of this alleged illegal amendment Agreement of the KESC for termination of the unconstitutional concessions granted to them. The Prime Minister was also requested to examine the allegation of non-recovery of US \$ 2.725 billion from Karkay Karadeniz Elektrik Uretim A.S.

On 19<sup>th</sup> December 2011, Joint Secretary (EA), Prime Minister's Secretariat sent a letter to Secretary, Ministry of Water and Power (U.O. No. 1(57)DS(E-II)11), asking him to furnish the comments by 23<sup>rd</sup> December 2011 as the issue has been inordinately delayed by the Ministry of Water and Power. However, no reply has been received by TI-Pakistan as of date.

TI-Pakistan again requests you to kindly apprise TI-Pakistan on the status of issues raised in the letter of 14<sup>th</sup> October 2011.
