## 1<sup>st</sup> Reminder

Sub: Complaint against Sui Northern Gas Pipelines Limited (SNGPL) of discrimination, favouritism by deliberate stoppage the supply of gas to DH Fertilizers Limited (DHFL) and Engro Fertilizer Ltd, and diverting its quota to Pakarab Ltd, causing business losses of over Rs 1 billion per month

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to TI-Pakistan's letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> December 2012, sent to the Prime Minister, on the above cited subject. However no reply/action has been taken even after a lapse of three months.

Transparency International Pakistan vide its above mentioned letter forwarded a complaint, requesting the Prime Minister to take immediate action and order SNGPL to comply with the commitments made to Engro Chemical Pakistan Limited in the Gas Sale and Purchase Agreement dated 11/4/2007, and to implement the Lahore High Court has been pleased to direct the respondents, through an interim order dated 13.02.2012 ("Interim Order"), in the Writ Petition No 3310/2012 to supply gas to DHFL in accordance with Allocation Policy and without any taint of discrimination.

Transparency International Pakistan again requests the Prime Minister to urgently take up this case.

Transparency International Pakistan is striving for across the board application of Rule of Law, which is the only way to stop corruption.
