Prime Minister's Strategy to combat Corruption

Short Term Steps.

Time Schedule 30 Days

Step 1. Commitment of Government of Pakistan for the application of Rule of Law in all government dealings and kick off the Prime Minister's Initiative against Corruption.

Event: Pledge of Federal and Provincial Governments, to the People of Pakistan at the International Convention to be held on **28 February 2015.** **Annex-A.**

Step 2. Prime Minister's Inspection Commission with assistance of Transparency International Pakistan to start a specialized fraud prevention and detection program to directly support development efforts. In order to achieve the aim, the PMIC will manage the Prime Minister's Anti-Corruption Hotline (PMsACH). The Hotline will be major source of Corruption information Intelligence. On **28th February 2015**, project of Prime Minister's Anti-Corruption Hotline will be announced by the Prime Minister. **Annex-B.**

Step 3. The Seven International Survey Sources of CPI will be contacted to know their requirements for Pakistan to satisfy their standards, which are reflected in their annual survey reports, which form the Corruption Perception Index by Transparency International. **15 February 2015** **Annex-C.**

Step 4. Meeting with MoF, FBR and FTO on the immediate concrete measures to be taken to plug annual revenue leakage of over Rs 2000 billion, and to increase the Tax GDP Ratio from 8.5 to 15 within 2 years. **20 February 2015**

Long Term efforts for Zero tolerance of Corruption. **Time Schedule 90 Days**

5. Meetings with procuring agencies for compliance of rule of law by all govt departments and PSE for procurement contracts and accountability of delays in project Implementation.

6. Meetings within 1 month with BOI for measures to be taken for the Curtailment in Cost of Doing Business and Time of starting new business. Permits etc.

7. Coordinate meetings within 2 months, for the compliance of various international anticorruption conventions, with International Anticorruption Programmes for Anticorruption measures improvement in Pakistan viz UNCAC. IACC International Anti-Conference. OECD. South East ASIA Convention. SARC etc

8. Work for the Improvement/new Laws for FOI, Right to Service and Whistleblower Protection Law.

9. Meetings with World Bank and Asian Development Bank for use of PPRA Rules in their Loans/grants, as TIP has been able to include PPRA Rules in US \$ 7.5 Billion Kerry Lugar USAID Grant for Pakistan.

10. Meeting with PPRA for amendments in PPRA Rules, for transparent and time based procurements amendments, and to include Public Private Partnership Rules.
11. Meetings on Computerization of Land Records, and stop of all land/property transfers till Land Records are Computerized.
12. Meetings within 2 months over 15 Regulatory Authorities, for formation of mechanism for strict implementation and compliance of their regulations.
13. Coordination with NAB, FIA and Provincial Anticorruption Departments for measures to be taken to expedite their efforts for the prevention of Corruption.
14. Monitoring and posting weekly progress of all Corruption Cases in accountability courts of NAB, FIA and provincial corruption courts on PMIC website.
15. Meeting with Judiciary for measures to be taken on ;
 - a. FBR recovery cases pending in Courts.
 - b. Early prosecution of corruption cases.
