Seminar/Symposium/Conferences, development of e-database by collection of financial crime data, development of intelligence network to detect corporate crimes, illegal assets/Benami Transactions, monitor mega /land/financial/corporate crime cases under investigation with ACAs and under prosecution with Courts, improvement in international rating of Pakistan in CPI/doing business, international cooperation, fraud in energy, power and privatization sector and follow up and development of Public Procurement System on modern basis/lines.

Transparency International Pakistan has on 30^{th} January 2015 prepared a detailed Prime Minister's Anticorruption Strategy , which comprises of 4 short term steps to be initiated within 30 days, and 11 Long Terms Steps to be initiated within 90 days. Copy is enclosed.

The Prime Minister's Anticorruption Strategy has been made based on the attached discussions held with PM on 23.11.2014, (Aid memoire) and strategy papers, communicated to the Prime Minister through Mr. Javed Aslam Secretary to the Prime Minister.

The directive of the Prime Minister to PMIC shall be taken by the Chairman, so that the planned and agreed strategy may be implemented without any delay, to achieve the desired results without further loss of time.
