If these information were not provided in the PPIB bid documents, it is non compliance of Rules, then this is a violation, amounting to mis-procurement under Rule 50 and to be dealt under Rule No. 2(f). **"corrupt and fraudulent practices"** which includes the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of any thing of value to influence the action of a public official or the supplier or contractor in the procurement process or in contract execution to the detriment of the procuring agencies; or misrepresentation of facts in order to influence a procurement process or the execution of a contract, collusive practices among bidders (prior to or after bid submission) designed to establish bid prices at artificial, non-competitive levels and to deprive the procuring agencies of the benefits of free and open competition and any request for, or solicitation of anything of value by any public official in the course of the exercise of his duty;
